Sacramental Preparation Policy

First Reconciliation and First Communion

The Archdiocese of Seattle requires a full year of formal Faith Formation prior to the immediate year of preparation for the sacraments of Reconciliation & Eucharist, along with regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Formal Faith Formation includes Elementary Faith Formation or Catholic School education. For further questions please contact the PA for Children's Faith Formation @ 360-491-0890 ext 108.

Continuing Formation

Children 3rd to 5th grade that have already completed First Reconciliation and First Communion. For further questions please contact the PA for Children's Faith Formation @ 360-491-0890 ext 108.

Confirmation

The parish requires one year of Sr. High Catholic Faith Formation or Youth Ministry prior to the immediate year of preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation, along with regular attendance at Sunday Mass. During the year of Confirmation classes, the youth are also required to attend Youth Ministry. Candidates must be 16 years of age by the time of the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation.

To fully enroll in Confirmation, an initial interview must be scheduled with the Coordinator for Confirmation at 360-491-0890 ext 103.

RCIA

The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is the process through which interested adults are gradually introduced to the Roman Catholic Faith and way of life. **Children** 7 years of age or older who were not baptized as infants are initiated through an adapted process of this Rite. The RCIA is also a venue for adults that were baptized as infants, but did not receive any further Faith Formation.

The RCIA is a continuous, open, and gentle year round process. The RCIA process is a period of reflection, prayer, instruction, discernment, and formation.

There is no set timetable and the people in the process are encouraged to take as much time as they need.

Those who enter the process are expected to begin attending Holy Mass on Sundays, attend a weekly RCIA session, attend all rites and retreats associated with the process, and to become increasingly more involved in the activities of the parish.
